

**Housing:** The Housing Authority of the City of Las Cruces and Dona Ana County Housing Authority are now accepting on-line applications for the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program waiting list. **Dial a Ride:** The City of Las Cruces Senior Programs Section thru the Transit Department provides curb-to-curb transportation services to qualified individuals 60 years of age and older who reside within city limits.
