Session 1 August 23 – October 7

Wednesday

Kids:
KB101 *Bookmaking* **4pm -6pm \$50 – Katy Stuckel**

Bring your imagination to life by designing your own personalized book! Kids will incorporate personal drawings as they learn to decorate papers, illustrate, write, and bind their own book. Ages 9-12, Studio B

Thursday

KC101 *Collage* **4pm-6pm \$50 – Katy Stuckel**

Come and experiment with paint, stencils, and found materials! Kids will get to create unique pieces of art by painting, cutting, and gluing. They will learn about the history of collage and how many individual parts can also make a whole. Ages 9-12, Studio A

You will explore new ideas while learning to understand clarity and shape variation, as well as many other important principles and elements of design. Comics, cartoons, and graphic novels are the inspiration behind this course. Students who like to draw, at any skill level, will learn to develop their narrative and graphic abilities.
