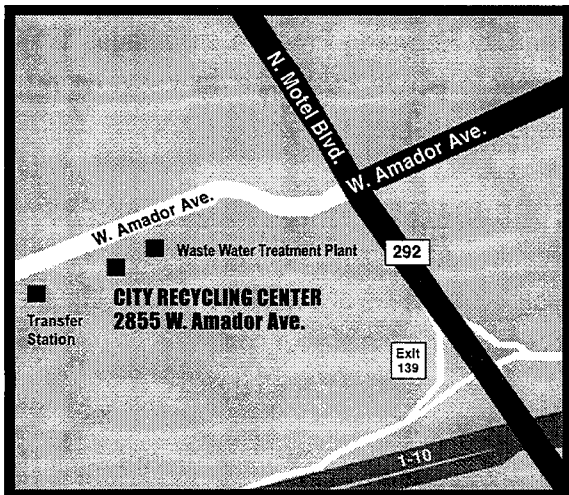

Yard Waste Recycling

The city recycles grass, leaves, tree trimmings and Christmas trees into compost. Yard waste must be taken out of bags and no trash or dirt is accepted.

Currently the Foothills Landfill also accepts clean fill: sod, bricks, concrete and uncontaminated dirt.



RECYCLING FACTS

- Americans use 50 million tons of paper each year.
- Each person uses and discards two pine trees every year.
- Recycling a 4-foot stack of newspaper saves the energy and resources needed to harvest and process a 40-foot tree.
- The energy saved by recycling one aluminum can is equivalent to the energy used viewing three hours of TV.
- Americans throw away enough aluminum to rebuild the entire U.S. commercial air fleet every three months.

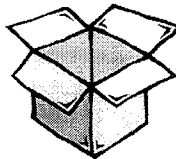
Accepted Materials:



- **NEWSPAPERS** - no magazines, slick or glossy paper, please!



- **ALUMINUM**



- **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD** (flattened)- and **BROWN PAPER BAGS** - No cereal boxes, discarded food containers or waxed produce boxes, please!

- **PLASTICS - #1 AND #2** - clear and translucent plastics include milk, water, and soda bottles.



- **COMPUTERS** - monitors, printers and hard drives

- **TELEPHONE BOOKS**

- **OFFICE PAPER** - white, photocopy, green bar, computer and shredded paper are recycled.



- **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** - household cleaners, pesticides, herbicides, motor oil, antifreeze, batteries, paints, stains, or any item considered ignitable, poisonous or corrosive. Ammunition and medical waste are not accepted.

- **TIRES** - a small surcharge is required, depending on size and quantity, to cover processing costs.



- **APPLIANCES and SCRAP METAL**- stoves, dishwashers, refrigerators, water heaters, air conditioners, etc.

Business Recycling

The City Recycling Program encourages businesses to recycle. Businesses may save on their disposal with two programs.

CORRUGATED CARBOARD CONTAINERS:

6 cubic yard containers are available for a low monthly rental fee of \$30.00 per month. The fee includes servicing of your container.

OFFICE PAPER :

Accepted paper includes:

- White office paper
- Computer paper
- Photocopying paper
- Green bar computer paper
- Shredded Paper

NOT Accepted

- Sticky or glossy paper-envelopes, packing paper or glue paper
- Colored paper
- Carbon paper
